## Getting there!

To Schoolies: Monday 22nd November

You must indicate on your medical form which bus stop you will be getting picked up from!!

(Meet at Bus bays at Service Centre on northbound side)

11.00am Private travellers arrive on site!!

3.00pm Centenary Pool

Coaches will arrive as close to schedule as is possible. Please arrive 20 minutes before time to allow for packing and unpacking of luggage.

If you are planning your own transport from camp we will be departing at 1pm on Saturday from Alex Park campsite.

**PLEASE NOTE : Schoolies are not permitted to drive their own cars during the Schoolies Event.**

## Where are you staying?

You will be staying at either Alexandra Headlands or Luther Heights.

More information on which campsite you will be staying at will be sent to you.

You will be notified in the next newsletter during October, around a month before you finish school!.

## The allow me to do stuff forms

**We cannot sign on your behalf so please don't forget. We will only reserve a place for you if you return your indemnity form.**

We give you 45 points to spend on electives, but you can buy more points if you want to do more things (1 point = \$1)
